On the evening of the First Easter Day, two of the friends of Jesus were making their way home to the village of Emmaus. They were sad and frightened. Sad because Jesus had died a few days before. Frightened because they were worried that they too might be arrested and sentenced to death.

Luke tells us that as they walked along the road, Jesus joined them and spoke with them, but they did not know it was him, until they sat down to eat and he said a blessing and broke the bread. They then realised that Jesus was alive. He had risen from the dead. They hurried back to Jerusalem to tell the others the good news, no longer sad, no longer afraid.

Help us to understand more about you and God's love.


And when we hear your words and know that you are with us,

and hear what you have to say to them. Amen.


